Summary*)
of the most important provisions of the liability
Insurance Contract with Rotary International,
Districts 1910, 1911, 1912, 1913 and 1920

Preliminary remark

The contract has been in place for many years. The main idea behind this insurance was the wish of the then Governors of Rotary International in Austria that the commitment to Rotary should not lead to uncontrollable liabilities and financial burdens. This also corresponds to a recommendation of the Rotary International headquarters in Evanston. Since most people in Central Europe have a private liability insurance, a secondary insurance was chosen. This meant that the premium could be kept very low.

Policyholder

Rotary International, Association of Youth Exchange of Districts 1910, 1911, 1912, 1913 and 1920, comprising Bosnia and Herzegovina, Croatia, Northern Macedonia, Austria (with the exception of the clubs Reutte and Kleinwalsertal), Slovenia and Hungary.

Sum insured

3,000.000 €**), lump sum for personal injury and damage to property

Subsidiarity

Existing insurances or insurances without a subsidiarity agreement that were taken out after the conclusion of this contract shall take precedence in the event of a claim. This shall also apply if only a partial insurance cover exists under another contract, namely for this part.

Insured risk

All characteristics, activities and legal relationships of the insured persons regarding all activities of any kind within the framework of the principles of Rotary International, e.g. charitable and social events, humanitarian and international activities.

Local scope of application

Europe

World-wide coverage is granted for the risks listed below:

- Personal liability of all Rotarians in districts 1910, 1911, 1912, 1913, and 1920 for participation in foreign Rotary meetings and events;
- Personal liability of youth, students, and scholars sent to other districts or countries, and business trips by accompanying Rotarians and officials.

Closing Remarks

It is a cover for clubs and their events. The General and Supplementary Conditions for Liability Insurance (Austrian Standard Cover) apply. These conditions do not cover, for example,

damage to property taken into use, or for instance, damage caused by the use of motor vehicles of all kinds (earth, air, water) and, for example, no cover for any commercial activity.

Europe is to be understood in the geographical sense; Iceland, Greenland, Spitsbergen, Canary Islands, Madeira, Cyprus, Azores as well as the Asian territories of Turkey and the CIS do not fall within the scope of the Europa cover.

In this sense, the insurance cover applies to Austrian and foreign law.

The insurance cover expires if the determination and settlement of damages or the fulfilment of other obligations of the insurer is prevented by state authority, third parties or by the policyholder himself.
